Phonetics, Phonology, Morphology, Syntax, Semantics, Pragmatics, Discourse, Sociolinguistics, Psycholinguistics, Neurolinguistics, NLP/Computational Linguistics, Indian and Western Linguistic Tradition, Language Teaching/Testing, Typology, Comparative Linguistics, Historical Linguistics, Semiotics, Field Linguistics, Language Endangerment, Language Documentation, Language & Conflicts, Grammatical Traditions, Stylistics and Translation Studies.

## Authors' Guidelines:

- Papers written in English (**formatted with 12 pt, Times New Roman, Single spaced**) are invited.
- An author can submit a maximum of 2 papers of which only 1 can be single authored.
- Submit your paper(s) along with abstract and references in \*.pdf as well as \*.doc format.
- Paper length: 4-6, A4 sized pages (including abstract and references).
